Master Applied Social Psychology

- In our program, we highlight which social psychological factors determine human behaviour, and how these factors can be influenced.
- > Based on social psychological theories, we outline how such factors can be studied, and how knowledge derived from research can be implemented in an applied context.
- > We teach, for example, about:
 - *stereotyping, prejudice and discrimination
 - *behaviour within social groups
 - *development and change of social norms
 - *crowd behaviour and collective action
 - *communication within and between groups
 - *health behavior
