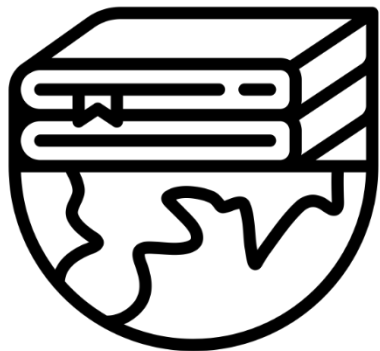

The perks of educational sciences

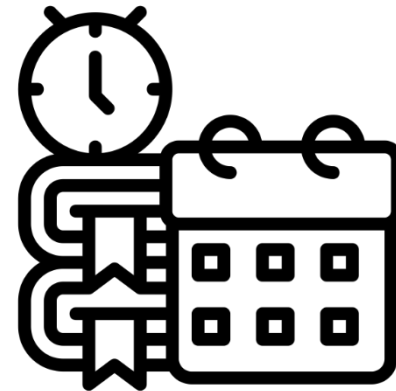
- > Combination of theory and practice.

The thesis (20 ects)

- > Usual in groups of 4 to 5 students
- > Under the guidance of a staff member
- > One-year trajectory
- > A complete study, from proposal to final report/thesis.
- > Can be anything from empirical data collection to more qualitative interviews or systematic reviews.

Practicalities



Full or parttime

- › From September 2024, it will be one of the few BSS courses that will also be provided part-time.
- › The full-time programme is one year, the part-time programme is two years.
- › Part-time is during the day; The first year consists of the courses, the second year of thesis and internship.
- › Make sure that if you register, you do so for the correct variant, because changing is not allowed.



Times and locations

- › Most of the education is on-site.
- › All education, except internships and exams, take place on Mondays and Wednesdays.



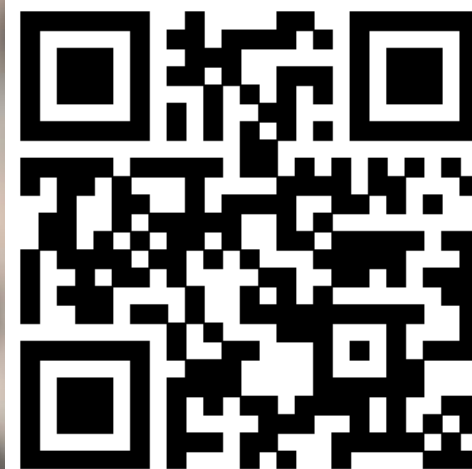


Application

- › Depending on your previous trajectory, you can either:
- › directly into the Master of Educational Sciences (Bachelor of Educational Sciences, AOLB)
- › Via the admissions committee if you are in possession of a relevant diploma (teacher, manager, psychology, sociology, etc.). The admissions committee can tell you whether you are admissible or which route you need to follow to be admitted (toelatingscommissie.pedok@rug.nl)
