5.1 International meetings organized in Groningen

CLCG members organized the following international meetings in Groningen in 2017:

Groningen Symposium on Language and Social Interaction

The third Groningen Symposium on Language and Social Interaction (GSLI) was organized by Center for Language and Cognition on January 19 and 20, 2017. The theme of this year's symposium was 'Survey Interview Interaction'. The symposium aimed to cover both qualitative and quantitative analysis of survey interview-interactions and brought together scholars interested in interaction in survey interviews, including interviewer-respondent and virtual agent-respondent interaction. The symposium was organized to honor Wil Dijkstra and Hanneke Houtkoop-Steenstra (1950-2002), two Dutch scholars that have studied interviewer-respondent interaction from different perspectives.

38st TABU Dag, June 22-23

TABU Dag is an annual conference on linguistics, organized by PhD candidates and a senior advisor of the CLCG. TABU Dag originated from the university's linguistic journal TABU (taalkundig bulletin, linguistic bulletin) and over the last 37 years has developed into a well-established conference with a varied program and guest speakers from different fields.

Five keynote speakers were invited. On the first day, Prof. Risto Näätänen (Academy Professor em. of the Academy of Finland, Professor of Cognitive Neuroscience of the University of Tartu, and Visiting professor of the University of Aarhus) opened the conference with a lecture titled "The mismatch negativity (MMN) as a unique index of decreased brain plasticity in different cognitive brain disorders". In the afternoon, Prof.

Anna Papafragou (Professor of Psychology and Language Acquisition, University of Delaware) gave a lecture about "Evidence and information in language and thought".

On the second day, the third keynote speaker Prof. Bart Geurts (Professor of Philosophy of Language and Logic, Radboud University Nijmegen) gave a talk on "Making sense of self talk". In between the day there was an NWO Open Access Session by Drs. Ane van der Leij (University Library, University of Groningen) who talked about "Open access publishing - Policies and opportunities in the Netherlands and at the University of Groningen". The fifth keynote speaker Willem (Jelle) Zuidema (Assistant professor in Cognitive Science and Computational Linguistics, University of Amsterdam) ended the conference with his keynote lecture on "Neural Grammars: building models that take both the brain and language seriously".

This years TABU Dag was a special edition with a new format! For TABU dag 2017, the organizers accepted abstracts for posters with flash presentations. All sessions were plenary, which means that each presenter had the chance to speak 2-3 minutes in front of the entire audience to introduce their research. In comparison to a programme with parallel sessions, this means that there is no need for the audience to move rooms between talks, and that presenters are guaranteed the full attention of all conference attendees. In addition, there is more time and space devoted to posters, which invites a deeper exchange about the research.

The organizers registered 130 participants and 80 poster/flash presentations.
